We are well into planning and preparation for a number of activities for 2017. Here's a brief snapshot of what we are planning:-

#### Domestic Violence Workshop - Tuesday 7 March

Following on from Ree Bodde's visit in November last year, we are hosting a workshop for the Community. Bev Cottell and I have been working with Lee Palumbo and Ree Bodde. There are posters up advertising the workshop and I trust this will continue to highlight the issue in our community and provide people with ways and means of helping to reduce and eliminate this aspect of our community life.

#### Sunfest Activities - 18 and 19 March

Sunfest will again be using the Village Green on Saturday and Sunday of this weekend. We will have our usual stalls and involvement on Saturday, including an open church.

On Sunday morning we will have our usual 8.30am and 5pm services, however 10.30am becomes difficult with parking and noise so we will not have a 10.30am service on this day. Instead, the 10.30am congregation are invited to attend the 8.30am or 5pm service.....OR......join with me in walking around the Village Green on Sunday morning and conducting a questionnaire with people. I will explain this more at an upcoming 10.30am service.

#### **Leadership Training and Mentoring**

Kim Beales and I are developing a Leadership Training Course, which will involve mentoring. We will be inviting people to take part in this over the next week or so. It will be designed to be run over 7 sessions meeting monthly, commencing in early April.

#### **Marriage Enrichment Course**

I have been keen to run a Marriage Course for some time, but other things have got in the way. Sharon and I, together with a small team, are now in the process of arranging a pilot course which we hope to run over May and June. Once the pilot is completed, our plans will be to open up the course for everyone later in the year, including those who have been married at St Mary's over the past number of years.

## **Building Update**

An update from your Building Committee-

The Building Committee continues to work towards our goal of being able to turn the first soil for our new worship centre for this year's 150<sup>th</sup> Celebrations.

In keeping with this goal, we continue to move forward with planning, with the following procedural requirements have now been undertaken.

November 17: Presentation to Diocesan Building Committee.

December 7: Approval to proceed received from Diocese with minor clarifications.

February 3: Preliminary informal meeting with presentation to Hume Council planning department.

During February / March the architects will begin to work on detailed drawings. This will involve input from structural, mechanical, electrical and communications engineers. This work will then allow for a formal planning submission to be presented to the Hume council. On current timelines we will ideally be in position to lodge this permit sometime in Whilst the process may sound April. protracted, the committee wants to ensure all known planning issues are addressed prior to any submission to enable Hume Council to be in a position to grant a planning permit. Once received this permit provides us with a two year window in which to commence construction.

The building committee will continue to engage with parishioners once we have received the detailed plans. These will hopefully be able to answer many of the outstanding questions from the consultation process around spatial, light and perspectives.

We are very indebted to parishioners who continue to uphold our building process in their daily prayers. We will continue to call for parish wide prayer support as we approach critical milestones, God has great plans ahead for us all.
